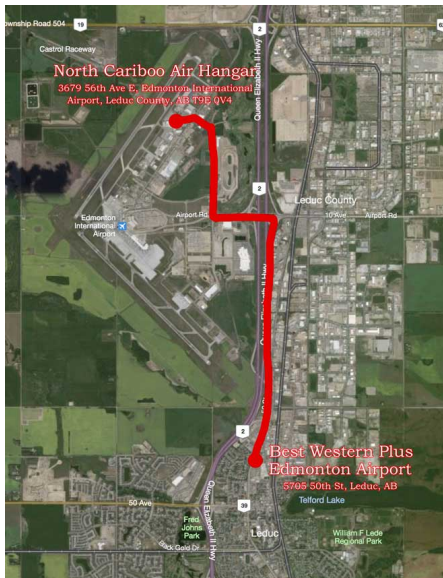


Cree River Lodge

- **Shuttle from hotel to charter flight**
Provided by hotel, will depart from the main lobby at 5:00 am



- **Charter flight from Edmonton to Stony Rapids**
Departs from North Caribou hangar at 5:30 am
- **Stony Rapids to the Lodge**
Upon arrival at Stony Rapids, a Trans West shuttle bus will take you to the float base, where you will board a twin otter for the 15 minute flight to the lodge.
- **Travel restrictions, etc**
Weight limit 50 pounds.

Before You Come

- Angling licence
 - In order to ensure you get the current year's licence, do not purchase until after March 31.

At Cree River Lodge

Day one

- Arrive in camp around 8:30 am
- Breakfast will be served
- Head out fishing when ready
- Box lunch for 1st day
- Shore supper (fresh fish and all the fixin's) at 7:00 pm back at the lodge.

Day 2,3,4 etc

- Breakfast at 7:00 am
- Your guide will be ready to take you fishing at 8:00 am
- Shore lunch out on the lake at noon
- Supper about 7:00 pm

Departure day

- You will leave camp about 8:30 am
- The charter flight will depart Stony Rapids approximately 9:00 am
- Expect to arrive Edmonton approximately 11:00-11:30 am
- North Caribou will provide a shuttle from their hangar to the main terminal
- Do not book connecting flights before 2:30 pm

Tipping guidelines

- Please bring cash for tipping purposes
- Our staff appreciate gratuities in recognition of good service. We recommend \$100 - \$250 per boat per day for guides, and \$25 - \$50 per person per day for shore staff. As always, any tips are entirely at your discretion.
