# At Cree River Lodge

### Day one

- Arrive in camp, time will depend on your flight schedule
- Breakfast/lunch will be served
- Head out fishing when ready
- Box lunch for 1st day, if appropriate
- Shore supper (fresh fish and all the fixin's) at 7:00 pm back at the lodge.

### Day 2,3,4 etc

- Breakfast at 7:30 am
- Your guide will be ready to take you fishing at 8:00 am
- Shore lunch out on the lake at noon
- Supper about 7:00 pm

### Departure day

- You will leave camp at a time appropriate to your scheduled flight.
- You will likely need to overnight in Saskatoon on your way home.

### Tipping guidelines

- Please bring cash for tipping purposes
- Our staff appreciate gratuities in recognition of good service. We recommend \$100 \$250 per boat per day for guides, and \$25 \$50 per person per day for shore staff. As always, any tips are entirely at your discretion.
